Tanya Houghton (Born.1985) is an interdisciplinary photographer and artist based in London. She has an MA from Goldsmiths University in Photography and Urban cultures and collaborates on a range of projects; editorial, commercial, exhibition, curatorial.

With a strong emphasis on the image as an object Houghton's current practice focuses on themes of ecology, centred around the landscape and memory. Though this she explores the connections between humankind and wild spaces, learning the stories we as humans imprint onto the landscape and in return the stories those landscapes tell about us, retelling them and preserving them for future generations.
